- Queens University Chancellor's Scholarship.** SCHS can nominate 1 candidate. Criteria include: Superior academic ability, creative and original thinking, and proven leadership qualities.
High school grades need to be 90%+
Annual value of \$ 9,000 and renewable for 3 years (4 years total)
50 scholarships available. **Must intend on studying at Queens and apply for your program by November 20, 2021.** As result, the SCHS Scholarship Committee would like to invite students who are interested in attending Queens to clearly state this in their application. Deadline to apply for this scholarship is **December 8, 2021** (after nomination)

- Schulich Leader Scholarship.** A prestigious scholarship – 25 at \$80,000 for science, technology, or mathematics – and 25 at \$100,000 for engineering, tenable at 20 partner universities in Canada. You need to meet at least two of the following criteria: Academic Excellence, Leadership (community, business or entrepreneurial), Financial Need. And **NOT** planning a career as a medical practitioner. One student can be nominated per school.

- Western National Scholarship Program.** Looking to go to **University of Western Ontario**? Will you have an admission average of over 90%? Then get your name in! The SCHS scholarship committee can nominate 4 candidates. The Western National Scholarship program is designed to recognize all-round excellence and is awarded on the basis of outstanding academic performance, demonstrated ability for creative and innovative thought, passion for the pursuit of learning and exceptional achievement in extracurricular activities. Level of Involvement	Describe the extent of your involvement. e.g. Are you passionate about the activity? How much time/effort was devoted to the activity/project?
